ROUTE TO GEERTRUDISKAPEL

From Utrecht Central Station to Geertrudiskapel: Leave the station following "Centrum" and keep right. Take the first right (by Blokker) then straight on past the Albert Heijn supermarket. Take the escalator at the Moreelspark exit. Turn left and cross over the road. On the other side, turn right (the Catherijnesingel) and follow the road for 300m. On the right, you will see a church with two identical towers. Just before the church, is the entrance to the Driehoek congress and meeting centre. Walking time 7minutes.
